

## Welcome to Camping field Kisokodo in Kiso Town, Nagano (キャンピングフィールド木曾古道：長野県木曾町福島)

Located between the Mount Ontake and Mount Kiso-komagatake, Kisokodo caters to a variety of camping needs. We offer RV Sites, Tent Sites, and Bungalows. The altitude here is 1030 meters.

There are many fun things to do in the area. Especially, we recommend that you check out the Nakasendo trail. Kiso-Fukushima was one of the Nakasendo post town thus it flourished as a political and economic centre in the Kiso Valley. The town of Kiso-fukushima has a grocery store, convenience store, onsen hot springs, some local museums, some restaurants and lovely cafes. Feel free to ask front staff anything about local information. Our friendly staff are happy to provide local recommendations to help you make the most of your stay.

### ACCESS

10 minutes by taxi or 1 hour by foot from Kiso-Fukushima Station. The way to the campsite is mostly uphill. We recommend taking a taxi, especially if you have heavy luggage, as the road is steep.

### CAMPSITE RATES (Depending on season and number of people)

★Tent / RV Sites: From 4,000 yen per site PLUS 600 yen per person.

Each tent site is 13m wide and 7m long.

We don't have tents for rent and electricity hookup.

★Bungalows: From 8,000 yen per bungalow PLUS 600 yen per person.

Maximum capacity is 4 people.



### AMENITIES (separated building)

Drinking water, sink, toilet, warm shower (24 hours free), reception house (9 to 5 PM), Wi-Fi, Dump station and laundry facilities, paid BBQ hut, Finnish sauna, camp equipment for rent.

### ACTIVITY

Playground, fishing pond, wildlife viewing, backpacking, stargazing and treasure hunting.

### IMPORTANT INFORMATION

Check-in time is 2:00 PM to 4:45 PM. Check-out time is 10:00 AM for bungalows and 11:00 AM for tent sites.

All major credit cards accepted for payment. Quiet hours: 9:00 PM to 7:00 AM. Please be considerate of others.

Cancellation fees apply for cancellations made 3 days or less before your arrival. To avoid attracting bears and other critters, do not leave food, coolers or cooking utensils in tents or out unattended at any time.

## PRECAUTIONS FOR USE

### 【How to throw away garbage】 ゴミの捨て方

Separate your trash in plastic bags and throw them away at the dumpsite in front of the reception house.

### 【Dumping place for ash】 灰は灰捨て場へ

Please dispose of used ash in the ash disposal drum in front of the reception house.

### 【Smoking free】 場内全域禁煙

No smoking is allowed within the entire premises. There are no designated smoking areas.

### 【Be quiet】 騒音に関する注意

Please refrain from any behavior that may disturb other users, such as shouting, music, or idle the engine. There is a quiet hour between 9pm to 7pm.

### 【Outdoor stuff for rent】 レンタル品はきれいに

Please clean the rental items before take it back them and let staff know any damage.

### 【Place of no open flames allowed】 バンガロー火気使用不可

Open flames are strictly prohibited inside the bungalows or on the terrace. Please use stoves and other open flames on the ground in front of bungalows.

### 【About your shoes off】 室内は靴を脱いで

Please take off your shoes when entering the bungalow room and the shower dressing room.

### 【Using household stuff】 家電品はブレーカー落ちます

Using household electrical appliances can cause the circuit breaker to trip.

### 【Parking problems】 車両トラブルは責任を負いません

Please resolve any parking lot accident and problems with guests among yourselves.

### 【Dealing with malicious users】 悪質利用者への対処内容

At our campground, we strive to provide a pleasant camping experience for everyone. Any selfish or disturbing individuals who are inconsiderate of their neighbors will be asked to leave the site immediately and banned from future visits. False reports of the number of guests, vehicles, or sites used, as well as illegal dumping, destruction of facilities or equipment, failure to report damage, or ignoring warnings will also be punished. Depending on the severity of each incident, compensation may be sought. Failure to report or refusal to pay compensation will result in a police report being filed.
